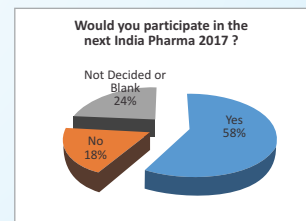
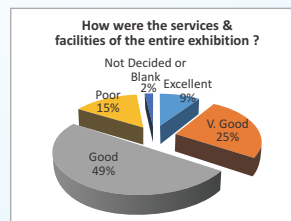
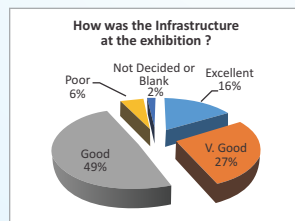
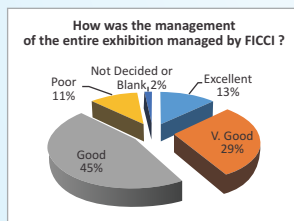


VISITOR FOOTFALL
