

1 Increase representation of all forms of diversity

- Collect data and ensure mapping and monitoring of strategic KPIs of diversity across G20 countries.



2) Establish safe and equal workplace

- Promote D&I in business strategies through incentives and regulations.
- · Empower underrepresented groups via tailored credit solutions, mentorship and networking programs.



(3) Promote inclusive environment for the future.

- Ensure budget for comprehensive support and quality education for underrepresented groups.
- Implement bias-free AI responsibly through public-private partnerships.
